

AIRD Scholarship: 2012/2013

In honour of its former **Lieutenant Governor John Black Aird**, the government of Ontario offers an annual scholarship for students with physical disabilities. The scholarship will be proposed again this year.

Deadline: April 27

Amount: \$2,500.00

Eligibility criteria:

The candidate must:

- ✓ have a physical disability that is a major, longterm impairment that severely restricts your activities;
- ✓ be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, protected person;
- ✓ be an Ontario resident. You are considered an Ontario resident if you have lived in Ontario for at least twelve consecutive months immediately preceding your registration in a postsecondary program in September 2012. This period may include time spent at an educational institution outside Ontario;
- ✓ plan to register in September 2012 in the **first year** of either an undergraduate degree program at a recognized Ontario university or a two- or three-year certificate program at a college of applied arts and technology or private postsecondary institution in Ontario;
- ✓ **not have previously received an Aird Scholarship.**
