Amount: \$5,000 CAD

Deadline: April 30th

Eligibility:

Applicants must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada

Applicants must have a permanent disability

Applicants must be currently registered in **and returning to** a full-time program of study at an accredited Canadian post-secondary college or university. Full-time status is at least 40% of a full course load.

Note: For the purpose of these awards, a permanent disability is a permanent functional limitation which affects the ability of the student to participate fully in post-secondary education.

Criteria:

Strong commitment to your academic discipline

Exemplary record of volunteerism and/or employment

Demonstrated potential to be an outstanding participant in the community

Selection Process

Once your application has been submitted, it will be reviewed for completeness and adherence to the above guidelines. Assuming all guidelines are met, selection committees review applications based on the selection criteria described above.

Due to the volume of applications received, only those selected to receive an award will be contacted. Recipients will be contacted by August 1.
