The Graduate contest is open to all graduate students (Master's and PhD)

Subject: A theme in the general field of religious studies

Language: English or French

Length: 3000-5000 words, typed and double-spaced

Eligibility: Master's or PhD student status in a Canadian university or Canadian graduate students registered in programs outside of Canada who are members in good standing of the Canadian Society for the Study of Religion (CSSR). There will be two awards given, one for the MA and one for the PhD.

PhD prize: \$700

MA prize: \$300

Deadline: 19 April 2012

The winners will be invited to read their papers at the next annual meeting. Submissions must include the full mailing address of the candidate and a letter from the chairperson or graduate coordinator of the department or programme certifying the degree and programme status of the candidate.
