

## Richard J. Schmeelk Fellowship Canada

### Objectives

- ✓ To promote intercultural awareness.
- ✓ To promote interprovincial studies.

### Award

- ✓ Financial assistance of \$10,000 per term, to cover academic costs, renewable for a maximum of \$40,000.
- ✓ Grant of up to \$1,500 for travel within Canada.

### Eligibility

Applicants:

- ✓ must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants
- ✓ must have completed a bachelor's degree
- ✓ must wish to pursue their studies in Canada's other official language, at one of the Richard J. Schmeelk Fellowship partner universities.

### Programs of study

- ✓ French-speaking students may apply to The University of Western Ontario (London, Ontario) or the University of Calgary (Calgary, Alberta).
- ✓ English-speaking students may apply to the Université Laval (Quebec City, Quebec) or the Université de Montréal (Montreal, Quebec).
- ✓ Students must select a program offered by their host university.
- ✓ Students may register for a two-year master's program or a one-year master's or Ph.D. program; if studying in Quebec, they may also pursue an undergraduate law degree.

### Application checklist

3. Submit the duly completed application package to the participating university of your choice.

### Application deadline

Applications must be postmarked no later than **April 15**.

### Fellow selection

After applications are assessed by the host university, the final selection is made by a committee consisting of representatives from the host university and The Schmeelk Canada Foundation.
