

Postgraduate Taught Country Scholarships

Scholarship Application Deadline: The closing date for application is **29 May, 2015**.

What does it cover? The Scholarship is worth £5000.

Eligibility criteria:

In order to be eligible for the Postgraduate Taught Country Scholarships applicants must have an offer for a full-time Master's program and assessed as an 'International/Overseas' student for funding purposes. Applicants must also come from one of the following countries/areas:

- Latin America and the Caribbean
- USA
- Canada
- Commonwealth of Independent States
- India
- Botswana
- Nigeria
- South Africa
- Zimbabwe
- Indonesia
- Vietnam
- Jordan
- Europe (Bulgaria, Cyprus, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Norway, Romania, Spain, Switzerland Turkey)

In order to be considered for this award you need to be wholly or partially self-financing and registered to start your studies during the 2015/16 academic year. If you have a conditional offer that includes English we will need a copy of your SELT test to show that your English level could reach the required level by October (either by retaking the SELT or undertaking a pre-session English program).

How to apply:

In order to apply you should send a 500 word essay to inform the Selection Panel on why and how the scholarships would benefit you, why you chose your program of study, and how you see your degree at Reading preparing you for life after graduation. We will also take into account your financial circumstances to ensure that as far as possible yours financial situation does not impede a university education. If successful you should expect to act as an ambassador for the University during our conversion campaigns.
