Applicants must have a diploma attesting to 12 years of education equivalent to the Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

Admission Requirements

Graduate Diplomas

- Applicants must have a degree/ diploma equivalent to a Canadian Honours B.A. having maintained a minimum average of 70%.

Master’s Programs

- Applicants must have a degree/ diploma equivalent to a Canadian Honours B.A. having maintained a minimum average of 70%.

Doctoral Programs

- Applicants must have a degree/ diploma equivalent to a Canadian M.A. having maintained a minimum average of 75%.

Study in French Scholarship

International students newly enrolled in one of the University’s French programs with a minimum admission average of 85% may be eligible to receive the following scholarships:

- **Honours B.A. and Master’s levels:** a \$1,500 scholarship per term.
- **Doctorate:** a scholarship of more than \$4,500 per term, i.e. the same tuition fees as Canadians.

Students who receive the Study in French scholarship are not eligible to receive an Admission Scholarship.
