1. Objective

This regulation establishes the administrative standards by which to judge the number of students required for a course to be offered.

2. Regulation

- 2.1 At the undergraduate level or its equivalent, a minimum of ten enrolled students is required for a course to be offered.
- 2.2 At the graduate level, the minimum is six enrolled students.
