Terry Fox Memorial Scholarship: Winner determined on the basis of an essay (750-1,000 words) on the topic "The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of people with disabilities."

Scholarship for Aboriginal Canadians: Winner determined on the basis of an essay (750-1,000 words) on the topic "The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of Aboriginal Canadians."

Scholarship for Visible Minorities: Winner determined on the basis of an essay (750-1,000 words) on the topic "The importance of quality public services in enhancing the quality of life of visible minorities."

Award Name: Tommy Douglas Scholarship/ Terry Fox Memorial Scholarship/ Scholarship for Aboriginal Canadians/ Scholarship for Visible Minorities

Eligible Fields of Study: any

Type(s) of Program: B.A.

Further Criteria:

- All children / grandchildren (including foster children / grandchildren) of National Union of Public and General Employees' current / retired members who plan to enter the first year of a Canadian public, post-secondary education institution full-time in 2017 / 2018 are eligible to apply.
- *Terry Fox Memorial Scholarship:* students with disabilities only
- *Scholarship for Aboriginal Canadians:* Aboriginal students only
- *Scholarship for Visible Minorities:* Visible minorities only
