## "Vatican II for the Next Generation" conference debuts today

OTTAWA, September 27, 2012 – The "Vatican II for the Next Generation" conference takes place at Saint Paul University from September 27 to 29, 2012. Organized by the Research Centre on Vatican II and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Catholicism, this conference will mark the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Opening of the Second Vatican Council.

At the event, many distinguished guests will focus on a number of theological and ecclesiological issues. As of today, 275 participants have registered and the conference is at full capacity.

Special guests include several bishops and theologians who contributed to the Council between 1962 and 1965. The "Vatican II for the Next Generation" conference has a vast program and three main lectures:
