



Bursary 2019

The Sophia Research Centre has been an active member of the research community at Saint Paul University for over 20 years. Originally founded to support women researchers and feminist thought at the university, the Sophia Centre continues this work through a range of activities, including the organization of research-centred events and bursaries.

The Sophia Centre is pleased to offer **2 bursaries of \$1,000** to support **full-time students** at Saint Paul University. The bursaries focus on research engaging with or related to justice and women, Trans and Two-Spirit people, gender and intersectional feminisms.

Applications will be assessed in light of the candidate's critical insights and analysis of social systems and how they impact on lived realities. A diversity of research areas will be considered as they reflect the many aspects of gender analysis.

Indigenous, racialized and bi-racial, and LGBTQ2S+ candidates are encouraged to apply.

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants should:

- Complete the application form, including information on financial need;
- In a one-page essay, demonstrate how their research engages with or relates to issues of justice and women, Trans and Two-Spirit, gender and intersectional feminisms;
- Provide two university-level letters of recommendation;
- Provide copies of academic transcripts.

SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS

The candidate's:

- excellent academic record;
- ability to successfully complete their academic program;
- research that meets the goals of the bursaries;
- financial need.
 - Applicants should not have not accepted other awards that altogether exceed \$10,000 per year.

The Selection Committee will be chosen by the Board of Directors of the Sophia Research Centre. They will give priority to candidates who best respond to the application criteria and selection considerations.

Please note that incomplete dossiers will not be considered.
