

APA-IUPSYS Global Mental Health Fellowship

The APA-IUPsyS Global Mental Health Fellowship provides a unique opportunity for a psychologist to contribute to the work of World Health Organization (WHO), in the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse (MSD) for a period of one year. The fellow will focus on one or more issues related to the WHO Mental Health Action Plan. For more information about the fellowship and its intentions, please visit the link posted below.

Deadline: April 30th, 2019;

Amount: \$22,000 (for a 12-month period);

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be an APA member or have applied for APA membership at the time of the application;
- Hold a doctoral degree from a recognized program in a clinical area of psychology;
- Be a psychologist of any career level with demonstrated research experience and leadership in at least on the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse priority areas indicated above (for more information about the department's priority areas, please visit the website posted below).

Application Process:

- Cover letter outlining the applicant's experience, expertise, and interest as they related to the goals of the program;
- Curriculum vitae;
- Documentation that the fellow can commit sufficient time and resources to fulfill the work plan during the fellowship year. It is anticipated that work plan activities will require a minimum of 20-30 percent professional time (FTE) to complete agreed upon deliverables;
- This documentation will typically include: a statement from the applicant's home institution confirming employment during the fellowship year and support for fellowship year activities, including recognition of time needed for research and program work as well as travel to Geneva for orientation and to Geneva or elsewhere for tasks specified in the work plan;
- Three letters of recommendation. Referees should be asked to address the applicant's goodness of fit with the goals of the program, with reference to clinical and research expertise, experience, and personal suitability for international work. The letters of recommendation can be sent separately for the applicant to APA's Office of International Affairs with the filename "LASTNAME-APA-IUPsys" (the address can be found of the website posted below).
- Applications must be submitted electronically. They should be sent as a single PDF file with the filename "LASTNAME-APA-IUPsyS" via email with the

subject header “APA-IUPSyS Global Health Fellowship Application” (the email can be found on the website linked below).
