The Bill 7 Award Trust was established in 1987 to provide post-secondary education scholarships to lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, two-spirited or queer (LGBTQ) students who are pursuing a first degree diploma or certification in any Ontario post-secondary institution and are in financial need. Since 1987, the Bill 7 Award Trust has granted over \$120,000 in scholarships to students in the queer community to help them with the cost of post-secondary education.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Attending or accepted by a post-secondary educational institution in the Province of Ontario;
- Pursuing your **FIRST** post-secondary program of study;
- You identify as lesbian, gay, bi-sexual, transgender, two-spirited, or queer (LGBTQ);
- You have demonstrated financial needs

Application Procedure:

- Copy of OSAP estimate (if applicable);
- Proof of registration/acceptance;
- Reference letter;
- Personal statement.
