

**Bisexual Foundation Scholarship Award**

The Bisexual Foundation Scholarship is an annual fund awarding up to \$1,000 per award to selected graduate students to advance research on the psychology of bisexuality. This new award recognizes the growing importance of research on bisexuality to the field of LGBT issues in psychology and offers concrete support and encouragement to emerging scholars in this field.

**Deadline: March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019;**

**Amount: \$1,000;**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Graduate students interested in advancing research on the psychology of bisexuality;
- Applicants must be currently enrolled full-time in a psychology or therapy/counselling graduate program. Applications from students in allied disciplines, such as gender studies, social work and sociology, cannot be considered at this time.

**Application Procedure:**

- A complete application consists of electronic versions of the following materials:
  - One completed cover sheet (this can be found on the scholarship website listed below);
  - One copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae (CV);
  - One copy of the project description (please omit identifying information – more information about the project description and important information that it needs to include, please visit the link below);
  - One letter from the applicant's faculty supervisor addressing the quality and feasibility of the project, and qualifications of the applicant.
