

Black Canadian Scholarship Fund

The Black Canadian Scholarship Fund was established in 1996 to encourage academic excellence and promote community leadership by providing annual scholarships to outstanding, young, black students.

Deadline: May 31st, 2019;

Amount: \$6,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a black Canadian student graduating from high school in the national capital region with a minimum average of 75% in: 6 grade 12 courses (U) or (O) or (M), or a combination of 6 grade 11 or grade 12 courses (U) or (O) or (M);
- Be a black Canadian Citizen and residing in the national capital region;
- Be admitted at a recognized Canadian University;
- Demonstrate a need for financial assistance;
- Demonstrate leadership in community involvement.

Application Process:

- A two-page essay explaining why this scholarship is important to the applicant and how the applicant will satisfy the eligibility criteria (e.g., academic achievement, school and community involvement, extra-curricular activities, education plans and financial needs);
- A photocopy of the applicant's latest official transcript of 6 Grade 12 courses (U) or (O) or (M) or a combination of 6 Grade 11 or Grade 12 courses (U) or (O) or (M) with a minimum average of 75%;
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher who taught you in the current academic year or a guidance counsellor;
- Proof of Canadian Citizenship (we will accept one of the following documents as proof: a Canadian passport; or a Canadian birth certificate; or a Canadian citizenship card/certificate).
