The purpose of this award is to honor excellence in provincial or national leadership by a CCPA member that encourages advancement of the profession.

Institution: The Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association (CCPA)

Deadline: December 1st, 2019

Amount: \$1,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- The nominee must be a CCPA Certified member in good standing for at least three (3) years;
- The nominee must be involved in ongoing professional development and/or program development at a provincial or national level;
- Demonstrate excellence in leadership by: **(1)** making major contributions through innovative research, publications, presentations related to the profession of counselling and psychotherapy; **(2)** advocating for a strong professional counselling educator/counsellor identity;
- Illustrate competence in counselling and effectiveness of both skills and service;
- Be involved both within and outside the work community to promote counselling and psychotherapy;
- Share knowledge and skill and professional colleagues, agencies, organizations, students, and the public.

To nominate:

- Any one (1) member of the CCPA other than the nominee must sign the application form;
- Information and documentation must be provided and sent electronically to substantiate the eligibility criteria started above;
- Electronic versions of supporting letters from at least three other professionals (not including the nominator) in the field must be provided.
