

Co-operative Housing Federation of Canada Diversity Scholarships

CHF Canada recognizes that the strength of its membership is in the many cultures and identities represented within Canada's housing co-ops. CHF Canada has joined with regional federations across the country to recognize and support young people living in housing co-ops who are actively promoting diversity in their community. The goal of the Diversity Scholarship program is to financially support emerging leaders of the co-op housing movement in their pursuit of post-secondary education.

Deadline: March 4th, 2019;

Amount: \$5,000 (distributed over 4 years);

Eligibility Criteria:

- Live or maintain primary residence in CHF Canada member housing co-op in Southwestern Ontario;
- Plan to attend publicly funded Canadian community college, university, or approved apprenticeship training program on a full-time basis in the 2019/2020 academic year;
- Have used their knowledge and understanding of diversity to make a positive contribution to their school and/or local community;
- Be under 30 years old;
- Demonstrate financial need,
- And agree to attend CHF Canada Diversity Scholarship presentation in the fall of 2019.

Application Process:

- Complete the application form (the application form can be found on the website linked below);
- Proof that they are registered as a full-time student;
- A transcript showing passing marks for the program;
- Proof that their accounts with the college or university are up to date.
