

Danahy Fiction Prize Submission Guidelines *(Information disponible seulement en Anglais)*

The Danahy Fiction Prize is an annual award of \$1,000 and publication in Tampa Review. Judging is by the editors of Tampa Review, and all entries will be considered for publication.

Deadline: December 31st (annually);

Amount: \$1,000 and publication in Tampa Review;

Eligibility Criteria:

- For this contest there are no specific eligibility criteria; however,
- Submissions are not accepted from current faculty or students at the University of Tampa;

Application Process:

- Submissions must be original, previously unpublished short fiction. We generally prefer manuscripts between 500 and 5,000 words, but stories falling slightly outside this range will be also considered. Simultaneous submissions are permitted, but Tampa Review must be notified immediately if the manuscript is accepted elsewhere;
- Manuscripts should be double-spaced and include a cover page with the author's name, mailing address, and other contact information, plus a total word count;
- A nonrefundable handling fee of \$20 is required for each manuscript submitted. Submissions are not complete until this fee has been sent using any major credit card via our secure online service (there is an additional small electronic payment processing fee);
- Complete the application form (the application form can be found on the website listed below).
