**Amount: \$1,500**

**Eligibility Program:**

- Must be a Canadian citizen or have a permanent resident status;
- Have a primary residence in one of the 13 provinces or territories of Canada;
- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Québec or Ontario;
- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019, at 11:59 p.m.;
- Must be enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or undergraduate degree in October 2019;
- Must have an average grade of 60% or equivalent;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.

**Master's Degree Program (M.A; M.Sc.)**

**Amount: \$3,000**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Must be a Canadian citizen or have a permanent resident status;
- Have a primary residence in one of the 13 provinces or territories of Canada;
- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Québec or Ontario;
- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019, at 11:59 p.m.;
- Must be enrolled in a Master's degree or graduate certificate program of study in October 2019;
- Must have an average grade of 60% or equivalent;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.
- Not have received a scholarship from any funding agency for the fall 2019 and winter 2020 semesters.

**Doctoral Degree Program (Ph.D.)**

**Amount: \$10,000**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Must be a Canadian citizen or have a permanent resident status;
- Have a primary residence in one of the 13 provinces or territories of Canada;
- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Québec or Ontario;
- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019, at 11:59 p.m.;
- Must be enrolled in a Master's degree or graduate certificate program of study in October 2019;
- Must have an average grade of 60% or equivalent;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.
- Not have received a scholarship from any funding agency for the fall 2019 and winter 2020 semesters;
- Not have received a Desjardins Foundation scholarship at this level of study.
