- As of October 2019, be enrolled in a vocational training program of at least 6 months at a recognized educational institution;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.

College or CEGEP

Amount: \$1,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or have permanent resident status;
- Have a primary residence in one of the 13 provinces or territories of Canada;
- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Quebec or Ontario;
- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31st, 2019, at 11:59pm;
- As of October 2019, be enrolled in a vocational training program of at least 6 months at a recognized educational institution;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.

Bachelor's Degree Program (B.A.)

Amount: \$1,500

Eligibility Program:

- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Québec or Ontario;

- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31st, 2019, at 11:59 p.m.;
- Must be enrolled in a Bachelor's degree or undergraduate certificate program of study of at least 6 months at a recognized institution;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.

Master's Degree Program (M.A; M.Sc.)

Amount: \$3,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or have a permanent resident status;
- Have a primary residence in one of the 13 provinces or territories of Canada;
- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Québec or Ontario;
- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31st, 2019, at 11:59 p.m.;
- Must be enrolled in a Master's degree or graduate certificate program of study of at least 6 months at a recognized institution;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.
- Not have received a scholarship from any funding agency for the fall 2019 and winter 2020 semesters.

Doctoral Degree Program (Ph.D.)

Amount: \$10,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a Canadian citizen or have a permanent resident status;
- Have a primary residence in one of the 13 provinces or territories of Canada;
- Be a member of a Desjardins caisse in Québec or Ontario;
- Have completed and sent the online form and provided all required documentation by March 31st, 2019, at 11:59 p.m.;
- Must be enrolled in a Ph.D. program of study of at least 6 months at a recognized educational institution;
- Not have received a full scholarship from Desjardins Foundation already covering the fall 2019 semester.
- Not have received a scholarship from any funding agency for the fall 2019 and winter 2020 semesters;
- Not have received a Desjardins Foundation scholarship at this level of study.
