

Gillis Purcell Memorial Journalism Scholarship
(Information disponible seulement en Anglais)

The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage Indigenous Peoples to pursue a career in journalism through a combination of studies at a Canadian post-secondary institution and experience in a newsroom. It was established in 1990 in honor of Gillis Purcell and his dedication to the quality of journalism as general manager of The Canadian Press from 1945 to 1969.

Deadline: November 1st (of each year);

Amount: \$4,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be an Indigenous Peoples (status or non-status Indian, Metis, or Inuit);
- Must be enrolled at a Canadian University or college;
- Must be enrolled in either a journalism program or actively involved with a news organization associated with the institution (e.g., student paper or broadcast station).

Application Requirements:

- Complete application form (found on the website);
- Résumé/CV;
- Cover letter outlining in detail your aspirations for a career in journaling.
