

Graduate Student Essay Contest – Society for the Study of Religion

The Graduate contest is open to all graduate students (Master's and Ph.D.) in a religious studies program.

Deadline: April 20th, 2019;

Amount: \$250 (M.A. prize); \$650 (Ph.D. prize);

Eligibility Criteria:

- Master's or Ph.D. student status is a religious studies program in a Canadian university; or
- Canadian graduate students registered in programs outside of Canada (include proof of Canadian citizenship) who are members in good standing of the Canadian Society for the Study of Religion (CSSR).

Application Process:

- Essays do not need to be written specifically for this contest. They may be assignments from a religious study course. Essays that have been previously published or are forthcoming publications are eligible;
- Essays must be accompanied by a letter of certification from the chairperson or graduate coordinator of the religious studies department certifying the degree and program status of the candidate, indicating that the student is in good standing in that university or college;
- Essays should be sent in Word format or text format;
- Completed application form (the application can be found on the website listed below);
