- Academic achievement;
- Involvement in community work and contribution to social causes;
- Awards, honors, and other achievements;
- Demonstrated leadership skills;
- A personal statement highlighting the applicant’s impact in the Ottawa community and how the applicant will help ICCC accomplish its vision and objectives.
- Reference checks.

Procedure:

- Evaluation committee comprised out of three representatives of the Indo-Canadian community will evaluate the applications.
