The Jeremy Dias Scholarship seeks to recognize a youth that has taken initiative in addressing discrimination in their school or community. This scholarship is offered by the Canadian Centre for Gender and Sexual Diversity (CCGSD) who intersectionally promotes diversity in gender identity, gender expression, and romantic and/or sexual orientation in all its forms on a national level through services in the areas of education, health, and advocacy.

**Deadline:** August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Must be a Canadian citizen;
- Must be a high school or Cegep student entering a post-secondary institution, or a student who is currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution;
- Ideally have worked to eliminate discrimination within their school or community
- Those working within their secondary school or community to address homophobia/heterosexism will be given special consideration.

**Application procedure:**

- A cover letter including full name, mailing address, email, phone number, high school name, and graduation date (on one printed copy);
- Two reference letters (cannot be from a relative);
- A current resume (one printed copy);
- An essay of up to 250 words describing efforts to eliminate discrimination in your community (one printed copy).
