

John Wesley Memorial Award

We sponsor up to two awards annually. The Award is valued at \$3,000 for College recipients and \$5,000 for University recipients. All Ontario residents who are First Nations, Inuit, or Métis, and enrolled in a full-time post-secondary institution in Ontario are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to applicants from Ontario communities.

Deadline: May 31st, 2019;

Amount: \$3,000-\$5,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Award is granted to students of Indigenous ancestry, who are enrolled full-time at an accredited university or community college in Ontario in one of the following programs: engineering, law, environmental studies, business, Indigenous studies, communications, human resources, technology, trades, or other disciplines related to Ontario Power Generation's businesses;
- Be in good academic standing (minimum B average);
- Have strong written and oral communication skills;
- Demonstrate leadership skills;
- Be involved in extracurricular community/campus activities, including volunteer work;
- Be Indigenous;
- Be a resident of Ontario;
- Be attending college or university in Ontario and be in at least the first year of a post-secondary program;
- Be legally eligible to work in Canada upon graduation and demonstrate an interest in working for OPG.

Application Process:

- Letter of introduction;
- Completed application form (the application form can be found on the website listed below);
- A record of academic standing (official or unofficial) from most recent academic program;
- Proof of First Nation, Inuit, or Métis status, as recognized and issued by the Government of Canada;
- Confirmation and acceptance for fall semester.
