

**Katherine Lemke Heinrichs Scholarship**

The scholarship was created as a tangible memorial of a woman, Katherine Lemke Heinrichs, who survived the loss of family, war; starvation, displacement, and transition to a new world with physically nothing more than what she could carry, but emotionally and spiritually, the strength to learn, rebuild, and thrive. Arriving in Canada in 1948, she learned a new language and a new way of life, established a home and a community, and persisted through hard work to support herself and her family, setting the part for her future generations to succeed in Canada. Her life tragically ended as a result of ill health only nine years later.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Must be a Canadian citizen and are enrolled at a Canadian post-secondary institution in your final year of an undergraduate degree or in a post-graduate program;
- Program is related to international development and human rights, involving the issues that face displaced persons or refugees, including but not limited to issues of food security, organizational structure, law and policy, crisis management, peace studies, or conflict transformation.

**Application Procedure:**

- Complete the application form (form is attached on the website of the application);
- Include a photo of yourself;
- Proof of citizenship;
- Essay;
- Most recent University transcript.
