The Maylon-Smith Scholarship is named for two founding past-presidents of the division, the late Alan Malyon and the late Adrienne Smith. It is a fund that annually awards up to \$1,000 to selected graduate students in psychology to advance research on sexual orientation and gender identity (SOGI). The award represents one of the division's major efforts to mentor and support science in LGBT psychology by encouraging the work of young researchers. Faculty members are strongly encouraged to inform students of this award so that we can continue to insure the future of LGBT research in psychology.

Deadline: March 30th, 2019;

Amount: \$1,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduate students in psychology;

Application Procedure:

- One completed cover sheet (can be found on the website of the scholarship linked below);
- One copy of the applicant's curriculum vitae (CV);
- A copy of the project description (please omit identifying information);
- One letter from the applicant's faculty supervisor addressing the quality and feasibility of the project, and qualifications of the applicant (for more information regarding the project description, please visit the link below).
