

Marion Dewar Scholarship Fund: Ottawa Community Immigrant Services Organization

The Marion Dewar Scholarship Fund (MDSF) was established by Ottawa Community Immigrant Services Organization (OCISO) in 2008, in honor of the late Marion Dewar former Mayor of Ottawa. The goals of the Scholarship Fund is to provide financial support to foster academic and leadership excellence in immigrant and refugee youth. The fund supplements the tuition and supplies required for their post-secondary education in the National Capital Region.

Deadline: April 26th, 2019;

Amount: \$1,500;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a resident of the National Capital Region;
- Be an immigrant or refugee;
- Demonstrate financial assistance;
- Be a graduating senior from high school or from another accredited secondary institution in the National Capital Region;
- Be pursuing a Degree/Diploma/Certificate from an accredited post-secondary institution in the National Capital Region;
- Have a good academic standing: a minimum GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale or 80%;
- Demonstrate leadership skills and community involvement.

Application Process:

- Completed application form (the application form can be found on the website listed below);
- A two-page essay explaining why this scholarship is important to you and how you satisfy the eligibility criteria (e.g., academic achievement, school and community involvement, extra-curricular activities, education plans, goals aspirations, and financial need);
- Latest transcript;
- Letter of reference;
- Proof of community work;
- Proof of resident status;
- Statement indicating the amount of money expected from various sources.
