

Mensa Canada Scholarship Program

The Mensa Canada Scholarship Programme offers a number of different scholarships. The awards range from \$2000-\$3000, and each has its own eligibility requirements. Mensa, the high IQ society, welcomes people from every walk of life with IQs in the top 2 percent of the population. The organization's purposes are to identify and foster human intelligence for the benefit of humanity, to encourage research in the nature, characteristics and uses of intelligence, and to promote stimulating intellectual and social opportunities for its members. It provides a forum for intellectual exchange among its members, who enjoy each other's company while participating in a wide range of social and cultural activities.

Institution: Mensa Canada

Deadline: January 31st, 2019

Amount: \$2,000-\$3,000

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be Canadian citizen or landed immigrant;
- Must be enrolled in a full-time program at a Canadian post-secondary institution, accredited by the applicable provincial Ministry of Education, during the 2018-2019 academic year;
- Applicants must be at least 18 years old on January 31st, 2019;

Application Procedure:

- The applicant must write a 250 word or less essay describing their career goals;
- The essay should describe specific goals (academic, vocational, or career). It should contain explicit ideas and information;
- Indicate the course of study and post-secondary institutions you are attending;
- Describe any steps that you have taken, relevant experience gained (e.g., paid or volunteer jobs, classes, honours, offices, organization), and any difficulties you have overcome in pursuit of your goal.
