

Mold Busters Scholarship

Ottawa-based mold removal company, Mold Busters, is launching a biannual writing contest for Canadian college and university students in order to raise awareness about poor indoor air quality (IAQ) and its effects on human health.

We invite students from any program in any Canadian post-secondary institution to submit an expository essay on the subject of mold, asbestos or indoor air quality in general. Students can explore the causes of air quality problems (moisture intrusion, humidity, poor ventilation, etc.) as well as their effects on building structures and human health. They can discuss effective remediation techniques as well as offer up practical prevention tips.

Deadline: April 30th, 2019; December 20th, 2019.

Amount: \$1,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Student must be a Canadian student enrolled in college or university;
- Must be written in English.

Application Process:

- Complete the application form (the application form can be found on the website listed below);
- Essays must contain the following topics:
 - Mold;
 - Asbestos;
 - Effects of poor IAQ on human and animal health.
