

NEADS National Student Awards Program

The NEADS National Student Awards Program is offered to encourage full access to post-secondary education for persons with disabilities, who often have greater barriers to participation in higher education, as well as extra costs because of their disabilities.

Deadline: May 15th (annually)

Amount:

- NEADS National Student Awards **(\$3,000 each)**;
- NEADS Holly Bartlett Memorial Award **(\$1,000)**;
- NEADS Christine Nieder Memorial Award **(\$1,000)**;
- AMI Robert Pearson Memorial Scholarship **(2 at value of \$5,000 each)**.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada;
- Must have a permanent disability (for the purposes of these awards, a permanent disability is a permanent functional limitation which affects the ability of the student to participate fully in post-secondary education);
- Must be currently registered in and returning to a full-time program of study at an accredited Canadian post-secondary college of university. Full-time status is at least 40% of a full course load.

Applicants must show:

- Self-advocacy;
- Strong commitment to your academic discipline;
- Exemplary record of volunteerism and/or employment;
- Demonstrated potential to be an outstanding participant in the community.
