The NRC Student Employment Program provides students with practical career-related experience in research and development, library sciences, communications, marketing and other areas. The Student Employment Program offers students a challenging and intellectually stimulating environment, while providing them with access to superior equipment, facilities, and expertise. Positions are offered to NRC research centers, branches and IRAP. Each term lasts for approximately sixteen weeks (four months) and work can occur full-time during a non-academic semester and part-time (up to 20 hours/week) during an academic semester.

**Deadline: October 1<sup>st</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup>;**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Have graduated with a high-school diploma;
- Possess a minimum “B” academic average or equivalent (preference may be given to candidates with a “B+” academic average);
- Must study at a recognized educational institution and are returning to full-time studies in the next semester;
- Are Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident of Canada;

**Application Process:**

- Most recent transcripts, please ensure that your full name is clearly indicated on your transcript;
- Must include a CV;
