- Pursuing a course of studies which will lead to a career to improve the quality of women's lives;
- Committed to working in Canada for at least two years after graduation;
- Intending to use the award for academic studies in the academic year following receipt of the award;
- Contributing to your community through volunteer service;
- Needing financial assistance.

- Proof of university registration (if applicable);
- Three letters of reference:
- Completed financial statement;
- Personal statement.
