

Terry Fox Humanitarian Award Program *(Information valid seulement en Anglais)*

The Terry Fox foundation was founded in 1982 in honor of Terry Fox, one of Canada's most beloved heroes. Terry Fox's perseverance touched millions of Canadians. The Canadian government gave two endorsements of \$5 million in 1982, and another \$10 million in 2006. The goal of this scholarship is to inspire and encourage young Canadians to seek the high ideal that Terry Fox exemplified through the pursuit of higher education. The winner of the award will be granted the distinction of being a Terry Fox Scholar.

Deadline: February 1st, 2019;

Amount: \$28,000 (max) dispersed over four (4) years;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be in good standing;
- Must be Canadian citizens or landed immigrants;
- Graduating from secondary (high) school or students completing their first year of CÉGEP or students who have completed secondary (high) school;
- Involved in voluntary humanitarian activities (for which they have not been compensated);
- Planning to or are already studying towards their first university degree or diploma at a Canadian post-secondary institution, or entering their 2nd year of CÉGEP in the upcoming year.

Application Process:

- Applications are to be submitted online;
- The applicant must provide three letters of reference;
- Application form;
- Unofficial transcripts.
