Deadline: April 3rd, 2019;

Amount: \$5,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident;
- USA or International students are also eligible to apply;

Application Process:

- Complete the application form (the application form can be found on the website listed below);
- An approximate 500-word Essay on:
 - **“How will I help bring people, communities, and a nations together”;**
- Proof of full-time enrollment;
- Proof of OSAP or equivalent funding; and
- Proof of identify.
