Deadline: March 31st (annually);

Purpose: To further the science of natural heritage management within the boundaries of Toronto and Region Conservation (TRCA) jurisdiction. Examples include, but are not limited to, forestry, water quality and quantity, hydrology, fisheries management, wildlife management, urban forestry, ecology, and ecological restoration.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applications will be received from students working towards post graduate degrees where the thesis work is being carried out in natural heritage management within the boundaries of TRCA's jurisdiction.

Application Process:

- Complete the application form (the application form can be found at the link posted below);
- Two letters of reference are to be accompanied with the application form, each in a sealed envelope (for authenticity purposes): one academic and one work related.
