

The CCA Internship Program

The program provides interns with an opportunity to gain experience working at the interface of science and public policy. Interns will participate in the development of assessments by conducting research in support of CCA's expert panel process.

The internship is a full-time commitment of six months beginning June 1st, 2019 through November 30th, 2019. Applicants must be recent graduates with a graduate or professional degree, or post-doctoral fellows, with a strong interest in science policy. Applications should include a CV, a cover letter, a writing sample, and two letters of reference, and be addressed to Joe Rowsell.

- Post-doctoral fellows with a strong interest in science policy.
