

## **The Justin Eves Foundation Scholarship** *(Information valid seulement en Anglais)*

The Justin Eves Foundation (JEF) is a registered charitable organization dedicated to serving students with learning disabilities and in financial need by providing bursary/scholarships for appropriate post-secondary education. The Justin Eves Foundation will provide financial support for Ontario students with learning disabilities who meet the application criteria attending a Canadian college or university or a post-secondary institution outside of Canada appropriate to their needs.

**Deadline: June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019**

**Amount: \$3,000 - \$5,000**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Longstanding history of learning impairment (even if LD was not clearly diagnosed in childhood, it is clear that the individual has dealt with learning challenges since childhood);
- Clear evidence that the learning problems are not better explained by other factors (such as acquired brain injury, Intellectual Disability, Autism Spectrum Disorder, ADHD, English as a second language, or psychiatric conditions);
- Evidence that the student has demonstrated personal initiative to overcome learning challenges;
- Evidence of community involvement;
- Evidence of academic success;
- Financial need.

- Provide documentation of a LD diagnosis;
