

The Reverend Archie MacLachlan Memorial Award Bursary Program

Each year the Canadian Foundation for Spiritual Care sets aside a bursary fund intended to assist persons currently enrolled in Supervised Pastoral Education (SPE) under the auspices of the Canadian Association for Spiritual Care (CASC) experiencing financial difficulty. Students may apply for the bursary once per fiscal year (June 1st to May 1st). Students must submit a completed application form that details their estimated financial expenditures and resources during the academic year. The goals of the program are to encourage and support current CASC/ACSS members, to promote education through CASC/ACSS accredited courses for individuals involved in the process of career development in spiritual care, and to work towards the professionalism of spiritual care providers and in turn to promote public awareness of the role and qualifications of spiritual care givers.

Deadline: May 31st, 2019;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a current CASC/ACSS member;
- Must be enrolled in a CASC/ACSS accredited course in either PCE or CPE;
- Consideration is given to those students in financial need;

- Reference letter;
