

Theological Education Bursary

The Anglican Foundation of Canada provides bursaries for theological education through a number of trusts and funds.

Deadline: April 1st and September 1st (of every year);

Amount: \$1,500 - \$2,500;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicants must have already completed an undergraduate university degree (B.A. or equivalent) unless the education institution had agreed to an exemption;
- Applicants must pursue studies at an accredited theological college or in any university theological program in good standing with the Anglican Church of Canada.

Application Process:

- Complete the application form (the application form can be found on the website linked below);
- Personal statement;
- Names of three references: one academic, one church-related, one character;
- A letter of reference (template attached) from the principle or dean (or equivalent) of the theological college confirming acceptance or continuance in the program;
- A letter of reference (template attached) from the bishop of the applicant's home diocese. (this letter is not required for lay applicants whose intended career path does not include ordination).
