

## **Transgender Research Award** *(Information disponible seulement en Anglais)*

The Div. 44 Committee for Transgender People & Gender Diversity is pleased to announce its annual \$500 research award for psychological research that addresses trans issues. This award will be given at this year's APA Convention and is open to anyone conducting psychological research using trans participants or studying issues affecting trans people and communities. The project may be complete (within the past three years) or in progress. The award winner will also disseminate and/or share findings with multiple audiences and communities that are directly impacted by the research (e.g., academic audience, traditional publications, community-focused workshops, etc.).

**Deadline: March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019;**

**Amount: \$500;**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Open to anyone conducting psychological research using trans participants or studying issues affecting trans people and communities;

### **Application Process:**

- A complete application consists of electronic versions of the following materials:
  - Cover page that lists the following:
    - Name of the award: Trans Research Award;
    - Name of the applicant;
    - Contact information;
    - Current degree seeking;
    - Institutional affiliation(s);
    - Study description (see below for specific instructions);
    - Curriculum vitae for principle investigator(s);
    - Notice of IRB approval;
    - Letter of recommendation (for students only, from the student's faculty supervisor; no more than one page per letter).
  - Study Description: The study description should be written in APA style (6<sup>th</sup> ed.). This should include a brief literature review, research questions, the methodology, and results (expected or achieved). The descriptions should be no longer than seven pages; this page total does not include references. Identifying information must be removed from the study description. APA style includes one-inch margins, 12-point Times New Roman font, and double-spaced pages.
