

Troop 17 Scholarship

The RCMP's Troop 17 Scholarship was established to recognize students who have made significant efforts towards the prevention of bullying and harassment in their schools and/or communities. Up to five scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded annually to full-time college or university students.

Deadline: March 31st, 2019;

Amount: \$1,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident who has reached the age of majority in their province/territory of residence;
- Be enrolled in a full-time accredited Canadian college or university;
- Demonstrate they have made significant efforts in preventing bullying and harassment in their schools and/or communities;
- Explain how they will continue to promote anti-harassment principles in their school and/or communities.

Application process:

- Complete application form (the application form can be found on the website listed below);
- Have two references validate your efforts (the reference form can be found on the website listed below);
- Provide proof on enrollment from the academic institution you are attending.
