

Wayne F. Placek Grants

The Wayne F. Placek Grant encourages research to increase the general public's understanding of homosexuality and sexual orientation, and to alleviate the stress that lesbian women, gay men, bisexual women, bisexual men, and transgender individuals experience in this and future civilizations. Since 1995, the Place Fund has granted more than \$1 million.

The Wayne F. Placek Grant encouraged research that addresses the following topics:

- Heterosexuals' attitudes and behaviors toward lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) people, including prejudice, discrimination, and violence;
- Family and workplace issues relevant to LGBT people;
- Special concerns of sectors of the LGBT population that have historically been underrepresented in scientific research.

Deadline: March 1st, 2019;

Amount: \$10,000;

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be either a doctoral-level researcher;
- Graduate student affiliated with an educational institution of a 501(c) (3) nonprofit research organization;
- Graduate students and early career researchers are encouraged to apply.

Application Process:

- Complete the online submission (the link for the online submission can be found on the website listed below);
- A complete research proposal (the requirements can be found on the website linked below);
- A project timeline;
- Detailed budget and justification;
- Abbreviated CV.
