Students live and study together on the campus of Schwarzman College, a newly-built, state-of-the-art facility, where all classes are taught in English. Students pursue degrees in one of three disciplines: Public Policy, Economics and Business, International Studies.

Further Criteria:

- Applicants who are currently enrolled in undergraduate degree programs must be on track to successfully complete all degree requirements by August 1, 2018 before orientation begins.
- Candidates must be at least 18 but not yet 29 years of age as of August 1, 2018
- English language proficiency
- There are no citizenship or nationality requirements
- Academic excellence will be a requirement for successful applicants, but there is no minimum GPA or class rank required to apply
