The *Sommario* contains three items: [1] [Carlo Maria Pedicini] to the archbishop of Québec [Bernard-Claude Panet], written after the general congregation of 18 apr 1831 [*recte* 14 may 1831; see *Cal. 1831-46* V 007]; [2] Jean-Baptiste Thavenet's memorandum; [3] Bernard-Claude Panet's memorandum, dated 25 sep 1830, answering the memorandum of the Sulpician Seminary of Montréal of 01 dec 1830 [this date is seemingly chronologically impossible].

It mentions the Jesuits in Canada and in Maryland, where religion had continued to thrive in spite of Protestant opposition, and ascribes the success of Catholicism in Canada [Lower Canada] to the erection of a bishopric [*recte* vicariate apostolic] in 1659 (between 1784 and 1840 Catholics grew from 113,000 to 600,000). The writer warns that he left the United States at the end of aug 1846 [00 aug 1846], and that, owing to constant immigration, "dans ce pays trente années sont trois siècles."
