

Licentiate in Canon Law (JCL) New Delivery Options

The Licentiate in Canon Law (JCL) degree at Saint Paul University, Ottawa, consists of 75 credits, 66 of which are from compulsory courses and 9 of which are from optional courses. The JCL curriculum is governed by *Veritatis Gaudium* and subsequent legislation and norms of the Holy See. The Faculty of Canon Law is pleased to be offering students *three options* to pursue the Licentiate in Canon Law (JCL).

TWO YEAR PROGRAM

Students achieve the JCL in six terms (Fall, Winter, Spring/Summer) spanning two calendar years (6 terms taken on campus)

THREE YEAR PROGRAM

Students take distance education courses over three years, with the second year and final term taken on campus (4 terms taken on campus / 4 terms taken at a distance)

FOUR YEAR PROGRAM

Students take distance education courses over four years, combined with on campus courses during four Spring terms (4 terms on campus / 8 terms taken at a distance)
