## 1. Objective

This regulation establishes the administrative standards by which to judge the number of students required for a course to be offered.

## 2. Regulation

- 2.1 At the undergraduate level or its equivalent, a minimum of ten enrolled students is required for a course to be offered.
- 2.2 At the master's level, the minimum is six enrolled students.
- 2.3 On the launch of a new study program approved by the Senate, the Administration Committee may grant a delay of up to three years regarding the minimum number of enrolled students required for a course to be given.
