First day to enrol (undergraduate students)	May 19

First day to enrol (graduate students)	May 19
First day to enrol cross institution courses UO	May 25
First day to enrol (special students)	May 19
Last day to enrol or change course selection	September 21
Last day to change student status (regular/auditor)	September 21
Last day to request leave of absence (graduate studies)	October 1
Last day to withdraw from a course or an activity and receive a financial credit, less administrative fees. The deadline to receive a reimbursement for the ancillary fees associated to a course may differ and even be earlier. Withdrawing from a course may affect whether you will meet all your program requirements. Be sure to consider all changes very carefully before going ahead. The date may differ for some faculties and programs, so please confirm date with your academic advisor.	October 1
Last day to withdraw from a course or an activity, no financial credit. The deadline to receive a reimbursement for the ancillary fees associated to a course may differ and even be earlier. Withdrawing from a course may affect whether you will meet all your program requirements. Be sure to consider all changes very carefully before going ahead. Course withdrawal is not possible after this date. If you simply stop attending a course and do not withdraw, you will receive a failing grade.	November 19
