Cisco Unity Connection Voicemail Guide

Access to voicemail

- From your telephone:
 - Press the Message button
- From another telephone on campus :
 - Press the Message button or dial **7000**.
- From an external telephone :
 - Dial the University's main number.
 - While the main greeting is playing, press *.
- Enter your ID (extension number), if asked, followed by #.
- Enter your PIN (temporary PIN: 12345) followed by #. (If you enter the wrong PIN, *Unity Connection* will ask for your ID and your PIN again.

Note: The first time you access the system, *Unity Connection* will ask you to record your name and greeting as well as modify your PIN. You can modify your name and greeting later by pressing #. You must however modify your PIN. A minimum of 4 numbers are required.

Controls while listening to a message

1	Restart message
2	Save message
3	Delete message
4	Slow down speed
5	Modify volume
6	Accelerate speed
7	Rewind
8	Pause or continue

Controls after listening to a message

1	Replay message

To restore deleted messages

- Press 3 to review old messages.
- Press 1 for saved messages or 2 for deleted messages.
- Press 2 to review messages or 3 to permanently erase all deleted messages.

To change your recorded name

- Press 4, 3, 2.
- At the tone, record your name followed by # or press * to keep the current recording. As you are recording, you can press 8 to pause or resume recording.

To change your PIN

- Press 4, 3, 1.
- Enter a new PIN and press #.
- Enter the new PIN again to confirm it and press #.

To record your standard greeting

- Press **4**, **1**, **1**.
- Record your new greeting and press # when you are done. If you
 press # without recording anything, the standard *Unity*Connection message will be used.

To record your alternate greeting

- Press 4, 1, 3, 3.
- Record your new greeting and press # when you are done. If you
 press # without recording anything, the standard *Unity*Connection message will be used.

To enable or disable your alternate greeting

- Press 4, 1, 2.
- If enabling, press 1 to specify an ending date or press # for an indefinite period.
- **Note:** The alternate greeting overrides the standard greeting if enabled. To return to the standard greeting, you must disable the alternate greeting.

To reply to a message

- After listening to the message, press 4.
- Record your reply.
- Press # to send the reply or press 1 for message options.

To forward a message

- After listening to the message, press 5.
- Record an introduction message (if desired) followed by #.
- Enter name or extension followed by # (To toggle between methods, press ##).
- Press **9**, **1** to enter another name or extension and repeat previous step.
- Press # to send.
