

### Saint Paul University Launches a New 5-Episode French-Only Podcast Series in Partnership with LeDroit

The final episode offers a reflection on the future of universities and the essential role they will play in tomorrow's society. This conversation will take place live at Université Saint-Paul, with Rector Louis Patrick Leroux and François Carrier, Executive Director at Le Droit. Everyone is invited to attend.
